DESIGNATIONOFTHEA UDITOR

MemorandumoftheSecretary -General

1. Article 25 of the 1978 Act of the UPOV Convention and Article 29(6) of the 1991 Act provide that the auditing of the accounts of the Union shall be effected by a State member of the Union as provided in the administrative and financial reg ulations, and that the State shall be designated, with its agreement, by the Council.

2. The Council decided, at its October 1999 session, to renew the designation of Switzerland as auditor of the accounts of UPOV for a period of four years, up to and including the year 2003, and thanked the Swiss authorities for their contribution to the workingoftheUnion(seedocumentC/33/17,paragraph 25).

3. Under the 1982 Agreement between the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) and UPOV, WIPO provides various administrative services to satisfy the requirements of UPOV including, *inter alia*, the financial administration of UPOV (Article 1(1)(iv)oftheWIPO/UPOVAgreement).

5. TheaccountsofWIPOareauditedbySwitzerland.Attheirordinarysessionstobeheld fromSeptember22toOctober1,2003,theAssembliesofWIPOand theUnionsadministered by WIPO are being invited to renew the designation of Switzerland as auditor of the correspondingaccountsfortheperioduptoandincludingtheyear2007.

6. The Secretary -General was informed that Switzerland was ready to accept the renewal of its mandate of auditor of the accounts of UPOV up to and including the year 2007.

7. TheauditingwouldbedonebyapplyingthesamerulesthatapplyinWIPO.

8. The Council is invited to renew the designation of Switzerland as auditor of the accounts of UPOV up to and including the year2007.
