#### facilitates:

- => good decisions
- => good definition of the object of protection
   (strong protection)
- => efficiency in method of examination (learn from the best)


#### **HARMONIZATION**


- => efficiency
  - mutual acceptance of DUS reports (minimize cost of examination for individual authorities)
  - mutual recognition of variety descriptions (all parties speak the same "language")
  - simple and cheap system for applicants (minimize cost for breeders)



PROPOSAL 2: Use of information provided in an electronic version of the UPOV Model Application Form (and possibly the UPOV Model TQ or UPOV Test Guidelines TQ)

- 1 The applicant would use the UPOV Model Application Form, and possibly the UPOV Model TQ or UPOV Test Guidelines TQ, to provide information to an authority as a part of an application for plant breeder's right.
- 2 It would be a matter for each authority to decide if it could accept such information as a part of the application and, if appropriate, the procedure to be followed
