ADMISSION OF NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS

(Request by the International Association of Horticultural Producers)

Report by the Office of the Union

1. By letter of September 24, 1974, the Secretary General of the International Association of Horticultural Producers (AIPH) expressed the desire to be informed about the meetings of the "technical working parties for the preparation of the Test Guidelines," to which other international organizations like CIOPORA and ASSINSEL were also invited. He asked that the AIPH be given an opportunity to submit written comments on questions being discussed at those meetings should it be unable to attend. A copy of the letter is contained in the Annex to this document.
2. The Council is invited to take a decision on the above request.
