NOTES AND LETTERS OF INVITATION TO THE DIPLOMATIC CONFERENCE ON THE REVISION OF THE UPOV CONVENTION

adopted by the Committee of Experts on the Interpretation and Revision of the Convention

1. The Annex to this document contains the drafts of the Notes and letters of invitation to the Diplomatic Conference on the Revision of the UPOV Convention, which is scheduled to be held in October 1978, and the lists of those States and Organizations to which these Notes and letters are to be sent. All drafts were approved by the Committee of Experts on the Interpretation and Revision of the Convention during its sixth session, in September 1977.

2. It is recalled that the Council decided that the Secretary-General of UPOV would issue the invitations to the Diplomatic Conference, if possible in January 1978.

3. The Council is invited to approve for distribution, subject to any amendment it might wish to make, the attached Notes and letters of invitation and the lists of addressees.

The Secretary-General of the International Union for the Protection of New Varieties of Plants (UPOV) presents his compliments to the Minister for Foreign Affairs and has the honor to invite, on behalf of the Council of UPOV, His Excellency's Government to participate in the <u>Diplomatic Conference on the Revision</u> of the International Convention for the Protection of New Varieties of Plants, which will be held at the headquarters of UPOV (34, chemin des Colombettes, Geneva, Switzerland) from October 9 to 23, 1978, and will start at 10 a.m. on Monday, October 9, 1978.

The working languages will be English, French and German and simultaneous interpretation will be provided in these languages.

The objective of the Conference is to adopt, on the basis of a draft submitted by the Council of UPOV, a revised text of the International Convention for the Protection of New Varieties of Plants of December 2, 1961, and the Additional Act of November 10, 1972.

./. The Provisional Agenda of the Diplomatic Conference (document UPOV/78DC/1), ./. the Provisional Rules of Procedure of the Diplomatic Conference (document ./. UPOV/78DC/2) and the Draft of the Revised Text (with explanatory notes) (document UPOV/78DC/3) are enclosed.

The Secretary-General would appreciate it if the comments, if any, of His Excellency's Government on any of these three documents could be communicated to him by June 30, 1978.

Assuming that the relevant provisions of the Rules of Procedure will be adopted as proposed in document UPOV/78DC/2:

(i) the member States of UPOV, that is, at the date of this Note, Belgium, Denmark, France, Germany (Federal Republic of), Italy, the Netherlands, South Africa, Sweden, Switzerland and the United Kingdom, will have full participating and voting rights in the Diplomatic Conference and the right to sign the revised text of the International Convention for the Protection of New Varieties of Plants;

(ii) any other States which are enumerated in the attached list adopted by the Council of UPOV will have the right to participate in the Plenary of the Diplomatic Conference, will be eligible for membership in its Drafting Committee and working groups, and will have the right to sign the revised text of the said Convention.

Attention is drawn to the necessity of providing representatives with appropriate credentials, including, where applicable, a statement expressly empowering one or more of them to sign the new Act of the Convention to be adopted. Credentials and full powers should be issued by the Head of the State or Government, or by the Minister responsible for external affairs (see Rule 6(3) of the Provisional Rules of Procedure of the Diplomatic Conference).

The Secretary-General would appreciate it if the names and functions of the representatives of His Excellency's Government could be communicated to him by October 1, 1978.
