- 1. At its forty -fifth session in Geneva on April 18, 2002, the Administrative and Legal Committee (hereinafter referred to as "the Committee") considered document CAJ/45/4, concerning the project related to the publication of variety descriptions and approved the scheduleofactivities as proposed under Section 6 of the Annextodocument CAJ/45/4.
- 2. The project focused on two main aspects: firstly, the need for a model study to investigate and develops olutions to the technical issues concerning the possible development and publication of variety descriptions, at the international level, in an effective way; and secondly, that there were important legal, administrative and financial issue s which would need to be resolved, by the Committee, before considering the possible introduction of an international system for the publication of variety descriptions.
- 3. This document deals with the second aspect, the consideration of the ad ministrative, legal and financial matters and in particular, as a first step, the development of a draft questionnaireasproposedinSection 6.2.1ofdocumentCAJ/45/4.

- 4. The first draft of this question naire has been prepared by the Officeo fthe Union on the basis of the project developed by the *adhoc* Working Group on the Publication of Variety Descriptions. The draft question naire is attached in the Annex to this document.
 - 5. The Committee is invited to consider the attached aft question naire.
