#### **UPOV 1991 Convention**

- Article 12 Examination of the Application -

In the course of the examination, the authority may take into account the results of growing tests or other trials which have already been carried out.



Such an approach is encouraged as an important means of *minimizing the time* for DUS examination and *minimizing the cost* of DUS examination by reducing duplication. (*TGP 5 Introduction*)

#### **Characteristics in Test Guideline**


TG of other authorities shall contain characteristics of Japan' TG.


#### **Criteria of assesment on characteristics**

Harmonize the criteria through joint observation meeting. (e.g. CPVO and PVP office of Japan)

Leaf blade: shape of apex









## Use of test reports

Joint meeting for harmonization of test method

Experience of use of test result from other authority

- Petunia, Calibrachoa (29 varieties)
- •(Chrysanthemum)
- •(Rosa)

Use of as a references for domestic DUS test

- •Lactuca sativa(lettuce) 1 variety
- Chrysanthemum 50 varieties

Case: Difficulties to carry out DUS test in Japan

- Brighamia insignis 1variety
- Humulus lupulus(hop) 1 variety

## Experience to provide DUS test reports

- Dianthus
- Nymphaea (no submission of plant materials)
- Cymbidium

Requests of DUS test reports from other authorities

- Dianthus
- Cymbidium
- Fagopyrum
