



UPOV – How to increase participation of new Members







Growing UPOV brings new challenges


Historically: UPOV was started by countries that already had existing PVP – infrastructure

- → adjustments of their law usually enough to qualify
- → already existing applications, testing

Since last decade many new members that started almost on zero

- → Much more effort needed to build up a system
 - → Politically
 - → Technically
 - → Financially

How can we help them?





Why do we need to increase participation of new members

Every member builds to 'the family"

New members may have evolving views and needs UPOV should not be static and respond to its members needs New members might help UPOV to develop important area's as:

- importance of PVP for agricultural productivity
- PVP and climate change
- links to biodiversity?
- links to farmers rights?



What are problems new members face

New members are confronted with many challenges:

- priorities: not only PVP law, but also execution of it
- establish institutions (PVP-office? DUS-station?)
- usually many costs in the beginning, but no income
- cost of participation in meetings;
- usually only interest in a limited #species;
- percieved high treshold (these TWP"s are for experts)
- where to get technical expertise? Where to learn?
- and more

Overcoming these challenges is not easy
