### PROPOSALS FOR CHANGES IN THE UPOV MODEL FORMS

FOR A REPORT ON TECHNICAL EXAMINATION, FOR AN INTERIM REPORT ON THE EXAMINATION OF A VARIETY, AND FOR A REQUEST FOR EXAMINATION RESULTS

### Document prepared by the Office of the Union

1. The present version of the UPOV Model Report on Technical Examination was last revised in 1986 at the twenty-second session of the Technical Committee. At that time, only the Variety Description Form was revised, the report itself (the first page) remained unchanged.

2. At the twenty-third session of the Technical Committee, it was proposed to align the first part of that report on the first part of the revised Variety Description Form (see document TC/XXIII/6, paragraphs 30 and 31). Mr. Baltjes (Netherlands) was asked to prepare a first proposal for revision for discussion by the Technical Working Parties at their sessions in 1988. The proposal from Mr. Baltjes is reproduced in document TWV/XXI/15.

3. The Technical Working Parties studied the above document at their sessions in 1988 and recommended to the Technical Committee to keep the first part of the Model as close as possible to that of the revised Model for the UPOV Variety Description Form, but to make several changes:

(i) The Report on Technical Examination should contain additional information on the agent and the breeder and should not contain information on the date of the UPOV Test Guidelines document or that of the national Test Guidelines.

(ii) The layout of the form for the report as well as for the variety description should be amended to provide a separate line for each item and all items should be presented in such a way that their was one column for the questions and a separate column for the answers.

(iii) Subitem 10 should be more aligned on the wording of the UPOV Convention (e.g. the word "clearly" should be inserted before "distinguishable").

(See documents TWA/XVII/9 Prov., paragraph 5(ii), TWF/XIX/11 Prov., paragraph 8, TWO/XXI/16 Prov., paragraph 9, and TWV/XXI/23 Prov., paragraph 10.)

4. The TWV further proposed considering whether items 7, 8, 9 could be combined with 10(a), 10(b) and 10(c), respectively, under the heading "Conclusion" and the heading "Results of the Technical Examination" could be deleted.

5. The TWC proposed that the changes mentioned under paragraph 3(ii) should also be applied to the "UPOV Model Form for the Interim Report on the Examination of a Variety" and to the "UPOV Model Form for the Request for Examination Results." These two UPOV models should furthermore be made easier to handle by including the required information on one page and not two pages as at present. The TWC considered that the above proposals facilitated readability and printing by computer and therefore recommended to the Technical Committee that it consider them favorably at the same time (see document TWC/VI/12 Prov., paragraphs 58 and 59).

6. The Office of the Union has prepared drafts on the basis of the above proposals and has aligned the various drafts on each other. They are reproduced as Annexes I (Draft for a revised UPOV Model Form for a Report on Technical Examination), Annex II (Draft for a revised UPOV Model Form for the Interim Report on the Examination of a Variety) and Annex III (Draft for a revised UPOV Model Form for the Request for Examination Results) to this document. The Annexes IV, V and VI contain the three above-mentioned Model Forms in their current versions for the convenience of the reader.

#### Explanatory Notes to the UPOV Variety Description Form:

- <u>General</u>: The reference number of the testing authority should be repeated on each page of the report.
- Ad Chapter A: Only information on the group to which the variety belonged should be given or information on groupings other than by characteristics listed in Chapter B. Grouping by characteristics mentioned in Chapter B should be indicated simply by marking the respective characteristic in Chapter B with the letter "G" before the number of the characteristic.
- Ad Chapter B: (i) All characteristics of the UPOV Test Guidelines should be reproduced, including those which are not applicable and those which have not been recorded. Those not applicable should be marked "not applicable," those not recorded, "not recorded".

(ii) The asterisks from the UPOV Test Guidelines should be repeated on the form.

(iii) Additional national characteristics should not be placed after the UPOV characteristics, but in their natural sequence, as the main purpose of the form is still for national use. They do not need to be specially marked as they are sufficiently identified by the national number.

(iv) The list contains only a small column for brief remarks or for a reference to lengthier remarks which should be reproduced in a footnote.

Ad Chapter C: Only those characteristics that show sufficient differences to establish distinctness should be given. Information on differences between two varieties should always contain the states of expression with their notes for both varieties; if possible, in columns if more varieties are mentioned.
