**RESULTS OF THE QUESTIONNAIRE ON TESTING OF SEED-PROPAGATED  
ORNAMENTAL VARIETIES**

1. At the thirty-fifth session held in Quito, Ecuador, from November 18 to 22, 2002, the Technical Working Party for Ornamental Plants and Forest Trees (TWO) considered document TWO/35/16, "Results of the Questionnaire on Testing of Seed-Propagated Ornamental Varieties". It was agreed by the TWO that this survey be repeated over the next 3 years to identify authorities with experience in DUS testing of seed-propagated ornamentals.
2. The questionnaire was sent to all members of the Union and the results are presented in the annexes to this document. Annex I contains the results of the questionnaire presented in alphabetic order of species. Annex II presents the results in testing authority order. Annex III presents the results in sections according to type of propagation of the varieties, namely: (a) seed propagated; and (b) vegetatively propagated.
