- 1. At its thirty -ninth session held in Geneva from April 7 to 9, 2003, the Technical Committee(TC)agreedtoinvitetheTechnicalWorkingParties(TWPs),theWG -PVDandthe WG-VDtoe xaminethecodesprovidedindocumentTC/39/13,duringtheirmeetingsin2003, andtomaketheirrecommendationsonthesuitabilityofthecodes.
- 2. InordertofacilitatethetaskoftheTWPsintheirwork,theOfficeoftheUnioninvitesthe Chairman of each TWP to identify those genera and species of particular interest for their respective TWP. The Chairman of the TWV proposed that the TWV consider the following taxa:

Allium, Anethum, Anthriscus, Apium, Armoracia, Asparagus, Beta, Brassica, Capsicum, Chamomilla, Cichorium, Citrullus, Cucumis, Cucurbita, Cynara, Daucus, Foeniculum, Humulus, Hypericum, Lactuca, Lens, Lepidium, Lycopersicon, Mentha, Ocimum, Origanum, Papaver, Pastinaca, Petroselium, Phaseolus, Pisum, Raphanus, Rheum, Rumex, Scorzonera, Solanum, Spinacia, Thymus, Valerianella, Vicia, Vigna, Zea.

3. The codes relating to these tax a have been extracted from document TC/39/13 Annexes I and II. Annex I of this document contains the tax a and their codes sorted alphabetical lybytaxa, and Annex I of this document contains the tax a and their codes sorted by codes.
