1. Comments from experts from the Netherlands

(a) Characteristics

1. To their opinion it is not the growth habit of the plant, but the habit of the leaves, which is observed

17, 20, 25, 26, 28, 30, 32, 34: to change 'globe(s)' into 'clove(s)'

(b) <u>Drawings</u>

- Ad. 11: to change 'Scape: length' into 'Scape: curvature'
- Ad. 15: in the drawings the difference between '1. transverse elliptic' and '2. ovate' is not clear.

2. <u>Comments and questions from experts from Poland</u>

(a) Characteristics

- 5, 6 which leaf to be measured should be indicated.
- 9-13 to change the order of characteristics into 10, 9, 13, 11, 12
- to propose the following characteristics which are in their national guidelines:

Scape: type: 1- only inflorescence

2- only with bulbils

3- heterogenic with buds and bulbils

Scape: number of bulbils: 3- few

5- medium

7- many

They also observe the size, shape and color of bulbils.

- 29 to have 'bulblet' replaced by 'globe' since it has green color
- 30 to read 'Globe: intensity of color'

(b) Explanation on the Table of Characteristics

"Growth key" might be added.
