 - > Technical visit,
 - > Matters to be discussed,
 - ➤ Workplan (e.g. time allocated for TGPs vs. TGs)
- To Update document: "Guidance Note: UPOV Technical Working Party arrangements" (meeting arrangement and technical visit):
 - ➤ Name badges
 - > Participant lists on large poster board
 - > Notice board for announcement

Possible measures for improving the effectiveness the TWPs GENERAL Cont'd

- To review the document: "Guidance Note: UPOV Technical Working Party arrangements" and include the key points in a cover letter (e.g. encourage national workshop in conjunction with the session to take advantage of international experts presence in the country; indicate earliest date for the first TWP and latest date for the last TWP to be organized after the TC)
- To announce the next TWP venue on the first day of the session so
 participants have sufficient time to reflect on suggestion for the agenda
 and the technical visit (invite the host to explain the intended program,
 e.g. technical visit)
- To introduce a session for open discussion in a similar way to the session in the TC




