

Robert BOEHM

After studying biology in Freiburg i.Breisgau 1988-1994, Robert Boehm received his Ph.D. in 1999 in the field of Pharmaceutical Biology (metabolic engineering) at the University of Tuebingen. He then joined the Institute of Molecular Physiology and Biotechnology of Plants at the University of Bonn as a junior research group leader, working on Molecular Farming systems. He spent some time at the Institute of Glycobiology at Oxford University and at the Institute of Agricultural Genetics in Hanoi/Vietnam to gain further experience in plant biotechnology. In 2007, Robert Boehm joined Selecta One in Stuttgart as head of research and development. 2014-2021 Robert Boehm was responsible for the group's central laboratory facility in Stuttgart, which includes plant pathogen diagnostics, in vitro culture and molecular breeding. From 2022 on, he is concentrating on the area of biotechnological research projects, research collaborations and patenting.
