



Moha FERRAHI

Dr. Moha Ferrahi was appointed Head of the Breeding and Genetic resources Conservation Department at INRA Morocco on November 1st, 2021, having previously held the role of lead the durum wheat breeding team to deliver varieties adapted to dryland agriculture.

Dr. Ferrahi holds a PhD in Genetics and Breeding from Kansas State University, USA in 2001 and M.Sc. in 1990 from the Agronomic and Veterinary Hassan II Institute (IAV) in Rabat, Morocco.

From 1990 to 2011 he worked for INRA in the development of new wheat varieties and has released several varieties. In 2011 he was appointed as Director for the Pillar 2 Resources Center (CRP2) of the Moroccan Green Plan that was established to assist in mobilizing expertise in conception and implementation of solidarity projects. In 2015, Dr Ferrahi joined the Regional Center of Agricultural Research in Meknes as durum wheat breeder. He occupied this position until his nomination of as Department Head at INRA headquarters in Rabat.
