



Hans ADU-DAPAAH

Prof. Hans Adu-Dapaah obtained his PhD in Plant Breeding and Genetics from University of Ibadan, in 1989. He joined the CSIR-Crops Research Institute (CRI) in 1993, became Chief Research Scientist in 2006. He has developed and released thirty-two improved crop varieties. He has over 220 publications to his credit. He has mentored 35 young scientists, supervised 45 PhD/M.Phil students, from local and foreign universities. He was the Director of CSIR-CRI (2008-2014). Currently he is the Vice President of CSIR-Graduate School. He is a Professor of Plant Breeding and Genetics. He was a member of the delegation that deposited Ghana's instrument of accession to UPOV Convention in 2021. He is a Fellow of Ghana Academy of Arts and Sciences. He is a proud recipient of over 15 career Awards including National Best Scientist(Presidential) Gold Award at First Ghana Science Congress in August 2011.
