Marcelo Labarta works in the Technology Transfer Office of the National Institute of Agricultural Technology (INTA) of the Argentine Republic.

He studied Agronomic Engineering at the Faculty of Agronomy of the University of Morón (Buenos Aires – Argentina)

From 1993 to 2011 he developed his professional career at the National Seed Institute (INASE Argentina) where he served as examiner of plant varieties, technical secretary of the National Seed Commission and Director of Varieties Registration from 1998 to 2011. He was a representative to the UPOV Council from 2001 to 2011.

Since 2011 up today, he has worked at the National Institute of Agricultural Technology (INTA Argentina) managing technology transfer agreements and is a representative for INTA before the National Seed Commission (INASE) and the Argentine Association for the Protection of New Varieties of Plants (ARPOV). He is also the legally authorized representative of INTA in applications for registration of plant varieties and breeder's rights and in applications for release into the environment with genetically modified organisms.
