Today Latvia became the fifty -first member of the International Union for the ProtectionofNewVarietiesofPlants(UPOV).

The purpose of the UPOV Convention is to encourage the development of new varieties of plants by granting b reeders an intellectual property right on the basis of a set of clearly defined principles. To be eligible for protection, varieties need to satisfy certain conditions, such as being distinct from existing, commonly known varieties and sufficiently unifor m and stable. New varieties of plants are one of the most powerful tools to enhance food production in a sustainable way, to increase income in the agricultural sector and to contribute to overall development.

The Secretary -General of UPOV, Dr. Kamil Id ris, welcomed the deposit of the instrumentofaccessionofLatviatotheUPOVConvention(1991 Act)andexpressedhis satisfactionthatUPOVhasnowreachedfifty -onemembers.
