












COLOR PATTERN ILLUSTRATIONS

FLUSH = hue of another color as a thin, transparent layer over the ground color of a surface		
BLUSH = hue of another color as a non transparent layer over the ground color of the surface		
SHADED = a darker shade of the same hue		schattiert
VARIEGATED = well-defined areas of different colors on one organ		panaschiert
PICOTEE = special color pattern of edge on a flower, where the edge is of a different, contrasting, color.		picotee
EDGED = secondary color around the edge of an organ		gerändert
VEINED = different color of veins compared to the rest of the organ		geädert
NETTED = secondary color as a net over the surface of the organ. TGP 14.2.1: Reticulate		netzartig
SPECKLED = secondary color as patches (irregular contour) TGP 14.2.1: Maculate		gefleckt
SPOTTED = secondary color as spots (round or nearly round contour)		gepunktet, gefleckt
STRIPED = secondary color as more or less parallel stripes.		gestreift
STRIATED = secondary color as fine, more or less parallel stripes.		striär, streifig
MOTTLED = secondary color as blotches that are not sharply outlined.		gesprenkelt, gefleckt, marmoriert
