The benefits for a country to become a member of UPOV, I think there are several benefits. From the side of the breeding community I think it's important to know when you release a variety in a country that there is this environment of plant variety protection available, that there is a set of regulations, a law available that protects those new varieties, otherwise I think breeders would be quite reluctant to sell or to release those varieties in those countries without plant variety protection. We have seen that studies, for example, the impact study by UPOV clearly indicates that as soon as a UPOV, a UPOV conform law is implemented in a certain country we see that the levels of plant variety applications go up, the number of breeders goes up, the number of foreign breeders that are selling varieties in a country go up, so I think those are, that's a very important parameter for a plant breeder to judge whether it wishes to, whether he wishes to, to sell a variety in a certain country.
